Bigger and Better

We were delighted to receive some funding from the National Lottery Community Fund which is allowing us to move in to a bigger office. We know some parents struggle to attend if they have to bring children due to the stairs. Our new office, directly opposite the lifts on the second floor, is now contained to allow you to bring children. We are hoping to have a small selection of fun toys and books to keep children entertained whilst you enjoy a warm drink and chat with fellow parents. The larger space will also allow for events and professional drop-in's with a more private environment to discuss any issues and difficulties. We will have a sign in the window so you can find us easily.

This extra funding will also allow for some more training opportunities and workshops which we will deliver from there. We have another exciting level 2 qualification being delivered by Michaela from Middlesbrough College, more details further on in the newsletter.

Some members of the forum are also being trained to deliver a course for parents called "Time out for Parents". This course is designed for parents who have children with additional needs with weekly sessions focusing on a different theme.

These sessions will be held in person at our offices for 3 hours once a week for 6 weeks.

We start by looking at what life is really like living with your child who has additional needs, helping them reach their potential and how to keep going. We consider how to boost self-esteem through play and learning, respond with good listening, and how our parenting style affects our children's responses.



The six sessions focus on the themes listed below:

- Session 1 – Parenting children with additional needs
- Session 2 – Self-esteem
- Session 3 – Coping with feelings
- Session 4 – Understanding behaviour
- Session 5 – Managing behaviour
- Session 6 – Home and school
- Session 7 – The wider family

We provide tips and strategies on each theme and practice or talk through these with parents before they leave so you feel confident to put these in place at home.

Be Heard Service

Be Heard is a free service offered to young people aged 11 – 16 years to help support and maintain mental health and wellbeing. The service is delivered in a youth club setting with different activities to give young people a safe and enjoyable place to meet with friends whilst gaining support and guidance from their trained Mental Health Youth Workers.

Be Heard currently runs from two locations, young people don't need a referral and can attend:

Guisborough Youth Centre
Every Thursday
4:00pm – 5:30pm 11-13 yrs
5:30pm – 7:00pm 14-16 yrs

A number of neurodivergent young people are accessing the service, however, it wouldn't be suitable for those with higher support needs. Summer HAF

We are pleased to offer some HAF Sessions over the 6 weeks holidays for our children and young people with SEND. These sessions will be open to families who receive free school meals free of charge. For families who do not receive free school meals there will be a small charge of £5 per child to attend, adults are free.

If your child is attending and has any allergies will be allowing parents to bring their own food if they wish. As allergies can be severe, we cannot guarantee that food would not come into contact with another food and are therefore allowing food from home. Allergen information will be displayed from the caterer at all events and it is up to parents to check any ingredients before children eat any of the food provided, especially if there is an allergy or intolerance.

Post 16 Transport

Following the consultation in February this year, we are aware that Redcar and Cleveland Local Authority are now reviewing their transport offer for those aged 16 and over. We have reached out to the LA to ask about the reviews and understand from the team, that transport should be reviewed each year, however this has not been the case in Redcar and Cleveland. Transport is now being reviewed and we have received the following response:

*Home to School Transport Update

Redcar & Cleveland Borough Council provide transport assistance to around 1700 students, it's important to review applications periodically in line with the policy to make sure that information about student needs and eligibility is up to date.

The Council are currently undertaking reviews of the transport applications, initially the main area of focus is on discretionary transport, however, other applications will be reviewed over the coming months. If your transport request is due to be reassessed you will be contacted by your school.

Post 16 Transport Update

Following the public consultation in February 2025, changes to the Post 16 Transport Policy have will be implemented from September 2025. You can view the policy [here](#). Current post 16 students who are continuing with their current course will continue to be eligible under the previous policy. Further information is being sent out to post 16 students who currently get transport assistance. The post 16 transport application form will be added to the web page from 31st May 2025.

We would urge anyone whose transport is currently been reviewed to ensure they forward all relevant documentation and information so this can be reviewed by the team.

SEND Family Voice Events

After half term, our drop in sessions are moving back to our offices and to accommodate parents that work we will be moving them to a Thursday. Starting Thursday 5th June, all drop ins will be in our new office 2T from 10am until 12pm. The enclosed office allows parents to bring children if they are struggling with childcare and also have a more private space to talk about any issues.
